COOKIE POLICY

Our Cookie Policy intends to describe the types of cookies used by the website www.francescoclerico.com (hereinafter 'Website'), the purposes of the cookies installed and the ways in which the user can select or deselect the cookies present on the Website and that use the services offered. We use cookies to make our Website easier and more intuitive. The data collected through cookies is used to make your browsing experience more enjoyable and more efficient in the future.

1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small text file in which brief information about a user's activity on a website is collected and stored on the device that accessed the website. Cookies do not harm your device and allow us to ensure a better and faster browsing of our website. Please read the information below to better understand what cookies we use and how you can manage your preferences regarding their use.

2. COOKIES INSTALLED

The cookies on this website are the following:

✓ Technical and Aggregate Statistics Cookies

These are cookies whose purposes are essential for the proper functioning of the website and to increase the functionality and performance of the website itself. Without them, certain operations would be very complex or impossible to perform. Such a cookie is also used to store a user's decision to use cookies on the website.

Technical cookies are not used for any other purpose and may be managed directly CERETTO AZIENDE VITIVINICOLE S.R.L. or by third parties.

Performance or analytics cookies also belong to this category. These are cookies that collect information, in aggregate and anonymous form, about the number of users and the use that they make of a website (e.g. information on which pages or sections of pages are most viewed and from which pages malfunction reports are received).

Google Analytics is a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. ('Google'). This Google Analytics integration anonymises your IP address.

✓ Profiling Cookies

4. DURATION OF COOKIES

Cookies have a duration dictated by the expiry date or a specific action such as closing the browser set at the time of installation. Cookies can be:

- ✓ **temporary or session**: these are used to store temporary information, allow linking of actions performed during a specific session and are removed from the computer when closing the browser;
- ✓ **persistent**: these are used to store information, such as the login name and password, so that users do not need to type them in again each time that visit a specific website. They remain stored on the computer even after closing the browser. Please note that, in accordance with the provisions of the Privacy Authority on the storage of personal data for profiling purposes, profiling cookies are stored on the user's device for a period not exceeding 12 months. At the end of this period, the user will be shown the banner through which it will be necessary to once again provide consent to the use of cookies. This is without prejudice to the possibility of the user to change the choices made at any time.

5. PROVISION OF CONSENT

For cookies that require consent, the first time users visit the Website they will automatically see a banner, containing both the link to this extended policy and the request to provide consent to the use of cookies. Consent may be provided by users by scrolling down the page and/or accessing other sections of the Website by clicking on links present on the web page below the banner (consequent action), or by closing said banner.

6. HOW TO DISABLE COOKIES
