Non-accessible content

The contents listed below are not accessible for the following reasons – non-compliance with Law no. 4 of January 9, 2004:

- Requirement: 9.1.1.1 – Some non-text content presented to the user does not have a text alternative that serves the same purpose;
- Requirement: 9.1.2.3 – For some pre-recorded multimedia, no alternative or audio description is provided;
- Requirement: 9.1.3.1 – In some cases, information, structure, or relationships conveyed through the presentation of the pages cannot be determined programmatically (or are not available through text);
- Requirement: 9.1.4.3 – The visual presentation of text and images containing text does not always meet the required minimum contrast ratio, except in cases allowed by the regulation (e.g., logos);
- Requirement: 9.1.4.5 – In some cases, text images are used instead of plain text and are neither customizable nor essential to the type of information conveyed;

- Requirement: 9.2.4.1 – There is no mechanism to skip blocks of content that repeat across multiple web pages;

- Requirement: 9.2.4.3 – On some web pages that can be navigated sequentially, and where the navigation order affects their meaning and functionality, some focusable objects do not receive focus in an order that preserves meaning and operability;
- Requirement: 9.2.4.4 – The purpose of some links cannot be determined from the link text or from the link text together with adjacent content;
- Requirement: 9.2.4.6 – Headings and/or labels do not sufficiently clarify content or functionality;
- Requirement: 9.2.4.7 – On some interactive elements, the focus indicator is not visible;
- Requirement: 9.4.1.2 – In some cases, user interface components (including: form elements, links, and script-generated components...) have incorrect or unset name, role, states, properties, and values, or the user and their assistive technologies are not notified when these change;
- Requirement: 9.4.1.3 – In some cases, status messages are not presented to the user in a way that allows assistive technologies to interpret them without requiring focus movement;
